It will present six works performed by 28 dancers age 9 to 75 with and without disabilities, including a new choreographic work that will explore themes of isolation, with company dancers starting from the movement range of the dancers with physical disabilities, letting their physical perimeters become both the inspiration and the manifestation of loss, isolation, and disconnect. Formally founded in 2015, Born Dancing produces original dance performances that feature performers with and without disabilities and creates dance education programs for under-served Students With Disabilities and High-Needs Students in New York City. Born Dancing programming provides Students With Disabilities and High-Needs Students with real-world dance performance and production experiences, apprenticeships to learn job and social skills, and internships in performing arts production and related fields. Ultimately, students and professionals together create transformative performances that demonstrate in no uncertain terms that artistic merit knows no boundaries.
